2. Scavenger Hunt

Customized Scavenger Hunt around the 50+ acre property of Twin Oaks Guest Ranch. Your group will be divided into teams and sent off on a scavenger hunt. At different stations they will have various tasks and be given tickets or items to collect. At the end, they will turn in their tickets or items and compile them to get donated for a cause. The client may choose the charity, or we are happy to give to a local charity.

This creates an elevated culture for your team by acknowledging philanthropy. Also gives your company a chance to change lives while having fun doing it.

3. Corporate Challenge

This engaging activity simulate departmental silo-ing and competition. Teams represent internal departments attempting to solve challenging issues within a limited amount of time. Each team is responsible for "doing their job" to earn points toward the company goal. The simulation reveals the benefits of working collaboratively and sharing information while adding fun and energy to any corporate event.

4. Mechanical Bull Riding

You will get to meet "Titan the Bully" - looks like an authentic bull. No other bulls come close. No toy bulls here that just spin around and make you dizzy. Our bulls bucking motion moves forward, backward, up, down, side to side, and spins which enables riders to have the most realistic experience in the industry.

This ride is extremely safe for all ages. Speed controls allow the operator to move the bull very soft and slow for first time riders or crank it up for the bull riding professional who thinks he's a tough guy or gal!

Known for being the toughest bully in Nashville according to the locals. Even though his horns and head are soft and safe for all ages, he still thinks he's a tough guy... Do you have what it takes to take on Titan?

5. Sip & Paint
